1996 Meetings:

Our meetings were held on the third Tuesday of the month. Programs included viewing the Video Series on Basic Family Research; a visit to the National Guard Museum where we talked about how to use the War of the Rebellion Index and books (A set of these are available at the NG Museum, at Rawlins Library in our genealogy library, and at the Archives); met at the LDS Church to work on our own research problems and hear about others' work.

In 1997 we plan to catalogue our library holdings, work with the city auditor in a computer listing of the Pierre cemeteries as well as looking at updating our files on the other cemeteries in Hughes, Stanley, and Sully Counties, and continue to assist in research. Our next meetings will be as follows:

FEBRUARY 18: Meeting at the UCC-Congregational Church on the corner of Prospect and Highland at 7:30 p.m. with an Executive Board meeting at 7 p.m. Election of officers and discussion of direction for our group. Each member is to bring the story of how his family came to be in South Dakota, and we will present information on Pierre area families. Program will be presented by Carla Sahr discussing research she and Henrietta Roberts did for their book.

MARCH 18: Rich will be back from Salt Lake and share his research with us. We will continue the presentation of Hughes, Stanley, and Sully Counties history.

APRIL 15: Family research - plans on cemetery updating - State meeting will be April 19 in Sioux Falls.
